Class Supplies

A neat, organized binder with appropriate contents is an important part of the AVID class. Binder checks are done once a week and are part of their overall grade. Along with class notes and tutorial worksheets, the contents must include:

- 2" – 3" 3-ring binder
- 2 or more pens
- Sufficient amount of extra paper
- Agenda book filled out
- Subject dividers or folders for each class
- 2 or more pencils
- 1 highlighter

Grading Policy

Grades will be posted in the classroom weekly. Students are expected to be in class everyday, participate, and do all assignments.

Points are distributed as follows:

Binders (binder, agenda, notes): 30%
Tutorials: 30%
AVID curriculum : 30%
MISC: 10%

Percent to letter grade is as follows:

A = 90% - 100%
B = 80% - 89%
C = 70% - 79%
D = 60% - 69%
F = 59% or below

AVID students must be dedicated to improvement in their classes. Progress will be monitored by both the students and by the AVID teacher. It is expected that the student maintain at least an overall 2.0 g.p.a. Students who fail to maintain a GPA which reflects strong work-ethics and progress will be placed on academic probation (excluding them from class privileges) and/or may be removed from the AVID program.
