

Fort Bragg High School Beginning Wood Syllabus

Beginning wood Technology is a year long course which provides students with the basic knowledge and skill of woodworking tools, machine use and woodworking processes. A great deal of enjoyment and satisfaction can be had by full participation in the course. Students will be fabricating projects from a wide array of choices and will be able to create projects of their own design. After completing two semesters of beginning wood with a minimum grade of B, they may progress to Intermediate Wood in subsequent years.

Since Wood Technology is an activities based class, students are expected to be working at all times, and will be evaluated on the performance in these activities and projects. Project grades will be based primarily on craftsmanship and work ethic (effort). Grades will also be determined by performance on test and quizzes. Students will not be allowed to operate and machine or power tools until they have passed the machine and power tool safety tests. Students are required to wear eye protection whenever anyone in the shop is engaged in woodworking activities.

Grading

Grading will be comprised of three weighted are as follows:

Effort and Participation	40%
Projects	40%
Tests and Quizzes	20%

Points for effort and participation are given for attendance, punctuality, staying on task, behavior, and overall effort. They are also given for helping the teacher and other students. Any excused absences can be made up with arrangements with teacher.

We will be making numerous projects throughout the year and students are expected to participate.
