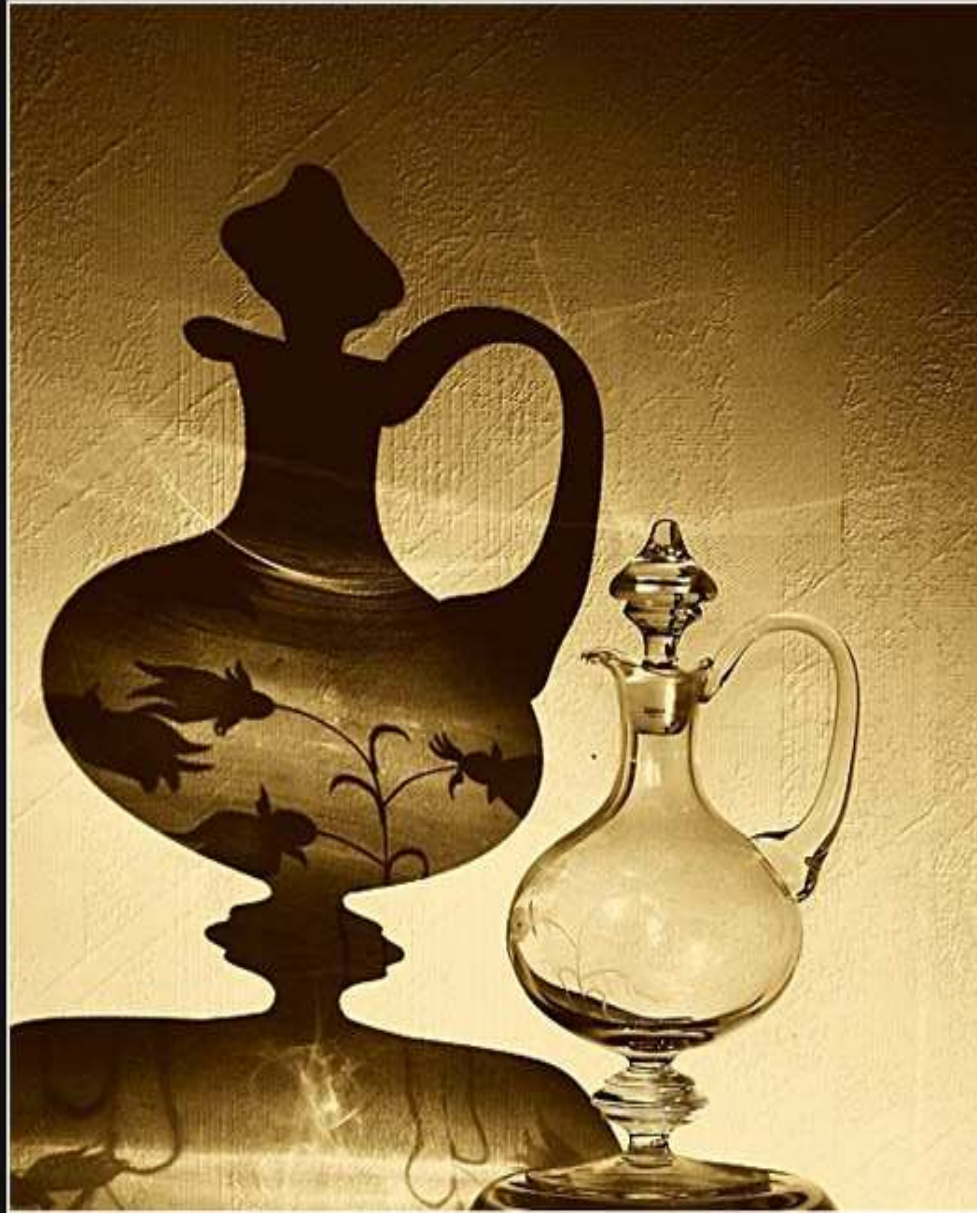

13 But all these worketh that one and the same Spirit, dividing to every man as he will.

14 For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.

15 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

16 For the body is not one member, but many.

17 If the foot shall say, Because I am not of the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

18 And if the ear shall say, Because I am not of the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

19 If the whole body were an eye, where were the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where were the smelling?

20 But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

21 And if they were all one member, where were the body?

22 And now are they many members, yet one body.

23 And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.

24 Much more those members which seem to be more feeble and less honourable, yet are necessary to the body.
